Directions:

Golf Course – we will always meet in front of tee box #10 (from the parking lot, tee box #10 is south and a little west of the golf clubhouse)

Dixon – the Carlton Trail Ski Club clubhouse is located NW of Humboldt. From Humboldt, go 8km west on Hwy 5. Turn north on the grid closest to (and just east of) the Pioneer Inland Terminal (*do not take Dixon Road – take the next road just west of Dixon Road; there is a blue highway sign with a skier on it*). Proceed 6.4 km north then turn left (west) at the corner with a CTSC sign and skis nailed a sign, on your left. About 1.5 km down this road, you will see the clubhouse (an old one-room school house) on your right.
